

**ACA Requirement to Have Health Insurance**

In March 2010, President Obama signed the Affordable Care Act. One provision of the Act required that in 2014 all Americans must have qualified health insurance or face a “Shared Responsibility Payment,” more commonly known as the Health Care Penalty. In order to remind you of the rules and to protect us both from future IRS liability in the event of an audit, we require all individual taxpayers who do not provide us with Forms 1095 showing insurance coverage to fill out this form.

- \_\_\_ 1. My entire household did not have qualified insurance coverage for the entire year.
- \_\_\_ 2. I (we) did not receive Forms 1095 because small businesses do not have to provide these forms to employees.
- \_\_\_ 3. Some, but not all, members did not have qualified insurance coverage for the entire year. We have provided Forms 1095 for those with coverage. Those without coverage are listed below:
